Kilwin's Expands in Grand Boulevard

Miramar Beach, Fla., (May 18, 2010) – A second Kilwin's Chocolates, Fudge & Ice Cream location is now open in Grand Boulevard. Paul and Kirsten Nykamp opened their first location three years ago and have expanded into a second location directly across from the Le Grand Cirque performance venue.

“We always had plans of expanding in the area, then we found out Le Grand Cirque was coming to the Town Center, practically at our front door. We decided to take the opportunity to capitalize on the traffic coming to town,” said Paul Nykamp.

The new Kilwin's kiosk carries 10 different flavors of ice cream – all super premium and especially made just for Kilwin's. Paying homage to everything “Grand,” the kiosk serves five specialty sundaes and one really special sundae, called the Grand Sundae.

“Think of the biggest sundae you can imagine and then serve it in a beach bucket,” said Kirsten Nykamp.

The Nykamps have teamed up with two of the Grand Boulevard restaurants to create one-of-a-kind specialty desserts. Chef Innocent Utomi from Fleming's Prime Steakhouse & Wine Bar makes a homemade cheesecake which is dipped into Kilwin's homemade melted chocolate then dries to create a hard shell.

Cantina Laredo Gourmet Mexican restaurant is making their homemade Mexican-style brownies as the basis for the Buried Treasure Sundae. It will have vanilla ice cream, homemade caramel sauce with whipped cream and a cherry on top.

The kiosk serves frozen bananas which are easy to eat and carry. Fresh squeezed lemonade is ideal for a hot summer day and is made to order.

Kilwin's new kiosk is located in Grand Park directly across from the Le Grand Cirque performance arena. It opens at 1 p.m. daily and both the kiosk location and the main Kilwin's located across from P.F. Chang's are open late.
